Fact Sheet: Lessons

Mission: Delivering quality training to build confident riders with an understanding of the classical principles of Equitation and a sound knowledge of the steps required to form a trust based relationship with horses.

Our instructors are committed to providing excellent instruction aiming to develop well rounded riders capable of riding a variety of horses both in the arena and in open country. Our coaching team attend weekly training to keep their skills up to date and continually improving and also ensure consistency and congruity within our team of instructors.

Lesson Programs:

We offer a range of lesson options to suit your needs: Casual, weekly by the eight week term, Riding club format (full day fortnightly or monthly), specialised clinics and workshops as well as memberships which include a leasing option. We can assist you with advice if you are not sure which option will be best for you. If you do not own a horse or if you are experiencing confidence or fitness issues with your own horse we have a stable of educated school horses chosen for their suitability as lesson horses. Of course you are welcome to bring your own horse also and lesson fees are adjusted accordingly.

Facilities:

Lessons at Academy Equestrian are presented in either the full size indoor arena, outdoor showjumping arena or the lunging (round) yard. To compliment the arenas we also have a 1.4km canter training track and a training cross country course. We are in close proximity to unlimited bush riding.

Location:

We are located Approx 40 minutes drive from Perth CBD. 10 minutes from Joondalup 20 minutes from Ellenbrook. The farm is 50 acres of undulating Pasture. A map is included on our website.

Our Horses:

The academy stable includes horse and ponies to suit riders of all levels and ages. Many of the school horses are retired from competitive careers in dressage, showjumping or eventing and most of the ponies have been trusted pony club mounts with years of experience to share with new riders. Many breeds are represented including warmbloods and thoroughbreds – we even have a Clydesdale cross! Our casual escorted trail rides are conducted on a dedicated team of trailies, mostly of standard-bred breeding, chosen for the purpose of carrying inexperienced riders safely through the bush.

Please Note Terms and Conditions:

- Paying by the term secures your lesson time, instructor and horse allocation each week. Please note that your place in a class cannot be held without pre-payment.
- Casual lessons require payment at the time of booking.
- We cannot guarantee that missed lessons can be retaken however providing we receive 24 hours notice of inability to attend we will inform you if there is a cancellation in another lesson group or timeslot in the same week, making a time available for a make up lesson.
- Please arrive ten minutes before scheduled lesson start time.
- Suitable clothing must be worn for riding – close fitting stretch pants, collared shirt or t-shirt with sleeve, boots or shoes with smooth sole and 1-2cm heel. Please remove jewellery and/or wear gloves over rings which may become caught in the saddlery. Any body piercing should be taped over prior to riding. We can provide boots and approved helmets for you to use during your lesson. Long hair should be tied back.
- We guarantee that each lesson will include a minimum of 45 minutes riding time, and a maximum of 20minutes Horsemastership training (tacking up, grooming etc) In extremely bad weather it may be dangerous to ride and so a practical lesson or demonstration on an aspect of horsemanship will be conducted in the barn or clubhouse. These lessons are planned to enhance the riders knowledge and are an important part of the curriculum so please ensure attendance whatever the weather.
